The Competitions were closely fought. The Cricket Association must be complimented on it's efforts in grading the teams.


Umpires were provided for all Senior Finals and most Junior Finals. Unfortunately adverse weather conditions prevented all but one match being decided on the pitch.

I think we definitely need to make allowances for this in future seasons.

Once again, the competitions were very tight after a couple of regradings. The combined trial of 13's and 14's went very well and I hope it is hear to stay. If we had two more sides we could have had three divisions, which would have been ideal.

Congratulations to all Coaches, Managers, Scorers, Players, Parents and supporters on your impeccable behaviour and sportsmanship. Whilst we had a couple of minor problems, the guilty parties were all regretful for their little slip-ups and should be commended for their attitudes.

Congratulations to all Competition winners who probably felt a bit down at the part the weather took. This was with the exception of the Under 10's who played a week later and completed a very exciting Final just before any rain could come and ruin it. It is hoped that spare weekends will avoid this happening in the future. Commiserations to the Finalists who missed a chance to play in the big one.




